Anyone age 10-16 must have a valid Snowmobile Safety Certificate to ride alone. This class will earn you that certificate. We will cover snowmobile terminology, winter safety, clothing, appropriate laws, etc.

All ages welcome.

Saturday, December 19, meet in the large meeting room in the Grand Lake Fire Station. Bring a light snack to get through the morning. Dress in layers; we will go outside for about 30-45 minutes to examine a snowmobile's components. We are asking a \$1 donation to cover pencils, postage, etc.

Sunday, December 20, meet in the Fire Station for the written test. After the written test, go to East Inlet for the driving test. You will need to provide a snowmobile and proper snowmobile clothing & helmet for the test.
