When do we depart? **Sunday's riding test at East Inlet, after written test**

What is the planned route for the ride? **Test track only, no actual club ride.**

Do we need to bring anything? **Warm clothing, helmet, snack**

NOTES: Always ride with a full tank of gas and carry extra oil, drive belt and spark plugs. It's a good to carry extra gloves, socks and any additional clothing layers you might need as the weather can change quickly. Make sure your cell phone is fully charged and that you store it on you to keep the battery warm.
